Methods of teaching remotely

- Every lesson will start with a live teacher introduction, starter ("You know the drill") and register
- From this point one of the following methods will be used:
 - Live lesson (Synchronous)
 - Sway
 - PowerPoint with attached tasks
 - OneNote
 - Research task
 - Practical task
- Irrespective of the method used, the teacher will remain available to the learner throughout the lesson to provide more support (staying on the call/chat/call back in)
