School uniform

You will be required to wear the DELTA school uniform and PE kit.

A copy of the uniform requirements can be found on our website and in the moving up guide.

You will receive a copy of the moving up guide on our transition days.

Bike Sheds

The bike sheds are next to the blue line. If you ride your bike or scooter to school you will need to bring a bike lock and keep your key safe.





The Blue Line

The blue line is next to the bike sheds. Once you cross the blue line mobile phones should not be seen or heard. You will be welcomed on the blue line each day by the senior leadership team and your learning manager. They will ask to see your student planner, knowledge organiser, jotter and equipment.



Student Entrance

This is the door you will walk through in a morning. It leads you straight into the canteen which is in the atrium. Tables will be set out for you to sit down.



ine Canteen

When you come into school you will walk straight into the canteen. The canteen is in the atrium. We have three lunch sittings. The Y7 lunch time is 12.30- 1pm. You will sit at a table and then be invited table by table to choose your food by a member of staff. Once you have chosen your food you will pay for it using your thumb and the money will be taken from your account automatically. You will then be able to choose a place to sit in the canteen. You must take your tray away and clear any rubbish after you have eaten. All food must be eaten at the table and not outside.



Break/Lunch Time

This is how the tables are set out before school, at break and lunch times.
There are members of staff on duty at break and lunch time if you want to ask any questions or need any help.



Thumb Machine

The thumb machine is in the atrium next to the hall doors. Your parents/carers can top up your lunch account online or you can bring money to put on this machine yourself. You can use this machine to check how much money you have left on your account. A copy of the menu will be available on the online account and your parents/carers will also be able to keep track of what you are buying and how much money you have left.



The Red Pledge Box

The red pledge box found on the image to the left, next to the thumb print machine, is where you will post your pledge forms and more information about the pledge system is in the moving up guide.



The Playground

The playground is at the back of the school. You can go on to the playground at break and lunch time. You are not allowed to eat or drink on the playground. There will be a member of staff on duty on the playground at break and lunch time.



Student Reception

Student reception is in the atrium. You can access student reception in the morning, break, lunch and after school. If you have lost an item of your equipment, clothing or if you need an exit slip you can go to student reception.



The Hall

The hall is in the atrium. We use the hall for collective worship. Each week you will attend collective worship with your house. Each form group has an allocated row to sit on.



Physical Education (PE)

The PE block is a separate building to main school. This is a picture of the entrance. When you go to PE you line up outside in your group and wait for your PE teacher to welcome you.





PE

Students will have the opportunity to take part in 12 different sports/activities each year. These will range from your more traditional sports such as Football, Badminton and Cricket to less traditional activities such as Handball, Kabaddi and Softball.

Students will also have the opportunity to take part in activities after school as part of our enrichment programme, they will be able to take part for fun or join one of the school teams and compete against other schools in a range of sports.



<u>ICT</u>

Here at RASA we are blessed with several modern computer suites that run lots of different software to give students the best possible computing experience. Students will learn about the following areas.

- Keeping safe online
- How computers work.
- Computer languages/programs.
- How to write programs.
- How to use a range of software.



Food Technology

The cooking room is downstairs on the technology corridor. It is one of the biggest classrooms in school. In year 7 students learn the basics, how to use the equipment, be safe and hygienic and healthy eating recipes.



<u>Art</u>

The Art room is upstairs. It is on the same corridor as the music room.

During your art lessons you will focus on the elements of art such as; texture, tone, colour and line. You will also use skills gained in ICT through photoshop activities with photography opportunities at GCSE level.



Music

The Music room is upstairs. It is on the same corridor as Art. In music you will learn about lots of different styles of music and get to try lots of different instruments. We have a large classroom with keyboards and computers, and 3 smaller rooms where you can find a quiet space to practice.



Science Labs

The science labs are downstairs. At RASA we have many science labs that look different to your usual classrooms. This is so you will have more room to take part in lots of different experiments.



Classrooms

This is what a typical classroom would look like in English, Math's, Geography, History, Spanish and RE. The teacher's name is displayed, tables are in groups of 4, each table has a purple box of equipment with resources to share. The class teacher will change the seating plans each half term.



Outdoor learning space

The outdoor learning space is on the playground at the back of the school. Your teachers may use this space during lesson time to complete practical learning activities.



Lockers

There are a number of lockers in school. More information regarding lockers will be outlined when you start in September.



First Aid

We have staff in school who are trained to deal with emergency first aid. If you feel ill during the day you should go to student reception.

The curriculum

- At Rossington All Saints Academy you will take part in the following subjects;
- Maths, Science, English, Geography, History, Spanish, Religious Education, Physical Education, Drama, Art, Music, Technology, Catering.
- There are a number of extra curricular clubs that you can also take part in afterschool such as sports clubs, dungeons and dragons, book club and many more. You will be told more information about them in September.

Uniform

- All students at Rossington All Saints Academy must wear the following uniform.
- DELTA Blazer
- DELTA Shirt
- DELTA Skirt or Trousers
- DELTA Tie
- Plain black shoes with no bows, buckles on them. <u>Trainers are not allowed.</u>
- No Jewellery can be worn e.g. ear rings, bracelets, necklaces, rings. You can wear a watch but it cannot be a smart watch.
- Make up and nail varnish are not allowed.

- <u>Uniform –</u> Should be arriving with you soon through your primary school. You can order more uniform from sptuniform.co.uk
- <u>Form Groups</u> We would like to return back to our vertical tutor system however this will depend on the DFE Guidance. Our Form Time Curriculum has continued to operate during our current structure with students in year groups.
- <u>Bus Service from Tickhill</u> You will receive further correspondence regarding the bus service provided by South Yorkshire Travel. This is a public service that does enter the school grounds to collect students from outside the school building. This is not a school operated service and we would advice that all parents ensure students are familiar with using public transport prior to September. - <u>Class Allocation</u> Due to students not completing SATS this year we will be guided by primary schools on academic ability, however students will complete DELTA Assessments within the first half term. Unfortunately children will not be placed in peer groups.
- Art GCSE Option -
- <u>Drama –</u> In KS3 students are part of a vocational carousel and rotate each term between Drama, <u>Art and Music</u>. We do offer a Drama Extra Curricular Activity Club.
- <u>September School Day</u> We are hoping that we can provide more guidance with regards to our school day at the next presentation.
- <u>Parent Pay</u> Your child will go on our system on Tuesday 31st August 21, from this point you will be able to sign
 up for parent pay and will receive information regarding this with your child's uniform bundle.
- <u>Funding to help close any gaps in Academic Learning</u> We are heavily supported by <u>Delta Trust</u> who are invested in pupil progress and academic learning, we continuously assess our students to allow us to quickly identify any gaps or additional resources needed.
